APPROVAL OF THE AMENDED ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME (EMPr) AND FINAL LAYOUT PLAN FOR THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF THE 301MW OYA ENERGY FACILITY AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE NEAR MATJIESFONTEIN, WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the above application by this Department on 29 April 2021, the amended EMPr and final layout plan received by the Department on 30 June 2021 and an email dated 12 July 2021, refer.

The amended EMPr and final layout plan were submitted to fulfil the requirements of Conditions 12, 13 and 14 of the EA dated 29 April 2021.

This Department has evaluated the amended EMPr and final site layout plan dated 30 June 2021 and found that the amended EMPr and final layout plan complies with the requirements of the conditions of the EA. It has been noted that the water pipeline (activity 9, Listing Notice 1) is no longer required for the proposed Oya energy facility, hence, omitted in the final layout plan. The amended EMPr dated 30 June 2021 and the final layout plan included as Annexure L in the amended EMPr are hereby approved.

The approved amended EMPr must be implemented and adhered to. This amended EMPr approval must be read in conjunction with the conditions contained within the abovementioned EA dated 29 April 2021.

This EMPr should be regarded as a 'living document', which may be amended from time to time as and when the need arises. For future amendments to this EMPr, your attention is drawn to the processes as outlined in the EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended.
